



Secure Your Flight with R-Controlled Boarding

In this game no one can board a plane without a boarding pass, but the only way to get one is to draw a word from the word pile and find the pass that matches the spelling and sound of the r-controlled phonogram in the drawn word.

Before play, review all the r-controlled phonograms making the sounds of /er/, /or/, and /ar/ that have been taught so far. Spread out the boarding passes face up so that the ones that sound the same are grouped together. Players place markers on the plane or train icons at one corner or the other of the Travel the World Chart printed below. The goal is to get to the opposite corner of the board before one's opponent can do the same.

Print, laminate, and cut out the playing cards, Boarding Passes, and Travel the World Chart. Keep the two sets of words separate so that the game can be played with one set or the other. If you print the two pages in different colors, the separation may be easier to maintain.

Before play, pile one set of words with the r-controlled spellings you have studied so far upside down next to the game board. Next, lay out the boarding passes for the r-controlled spellings you have studied, face up near the word cards. Each player should be given as many markers as is appropriate for the amount of time available to play. In each turn players draw a word card and pick up the boarding card that matches both sound and spelling of the r-controlled spelling in the drawn word. Only then can they "board a plane or a train" and take their marker three steps toward the opposite corner of the world. Extra hops can be taken when another playing piece is met as in traditional Chinese Checkers. Hopping over a piece, however, does not remove it from play. The winner is the one who gets all of his or her markers to the opposite corner of the world first.

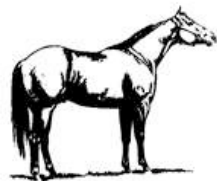

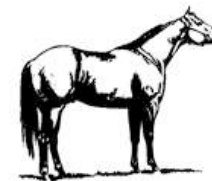
