

Two Vowels Go Walking Tic-tac-toe

Preparation:

Print-out and laminate, the "word shells" Tic-tac-toe board and the vowel team cards printed above.

Cut out the vowel cards and Spread them out face-down near the board.

Assemble markers for each player such as pennies and dimes or differently colored disks to take the place of X and O in traditional tic-tac-toe.

Directions for play:

Players take turns drawing a vowel-team card from the pile and placing it within a word shell on the Tic-tac-toe board wherever it will make a real English word.

When a word is made the player can put a marker on that square.

When a player completes a line, vertically, horizontally, or diagonally, a round has been won. The winner is the one with the most rounds won when time is up.
